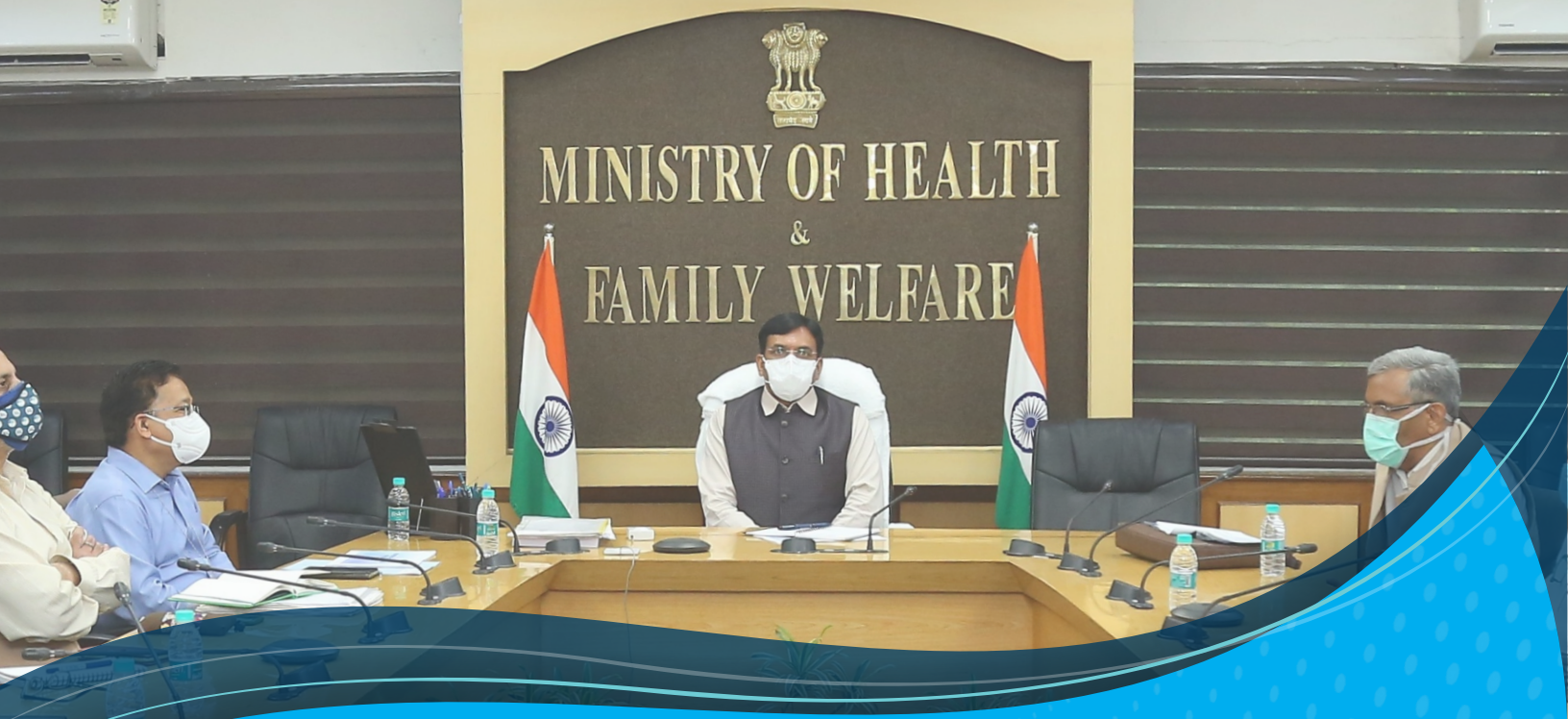

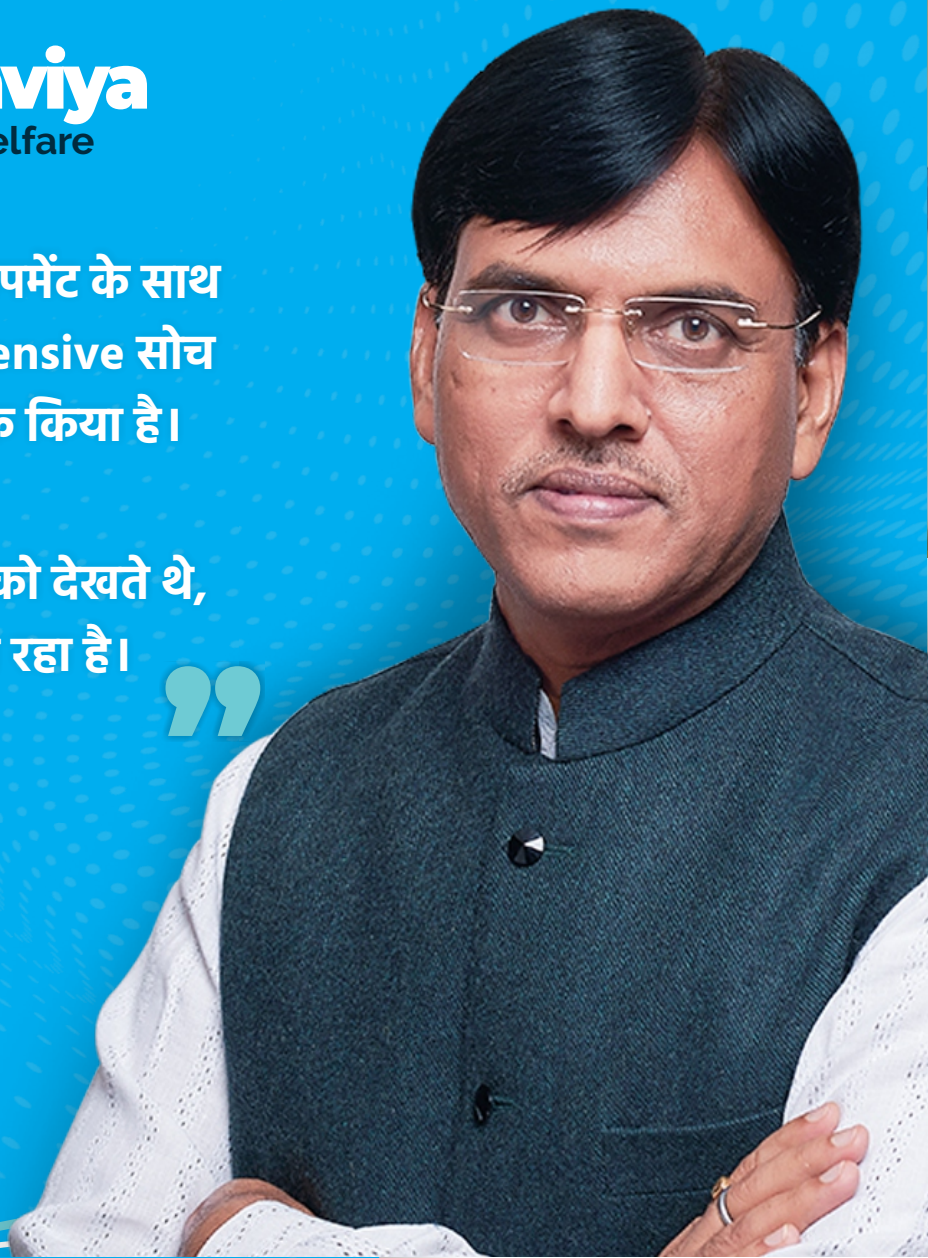

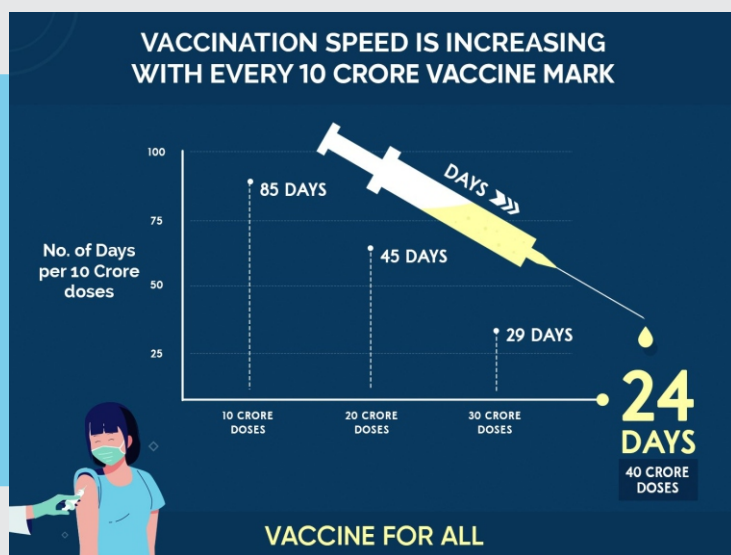
## Meeting with Hon'ble Vice President of India

Increasing the speed of vaccination, India achieved the landmark of 40 crore vaccine doses in a very short period of time.

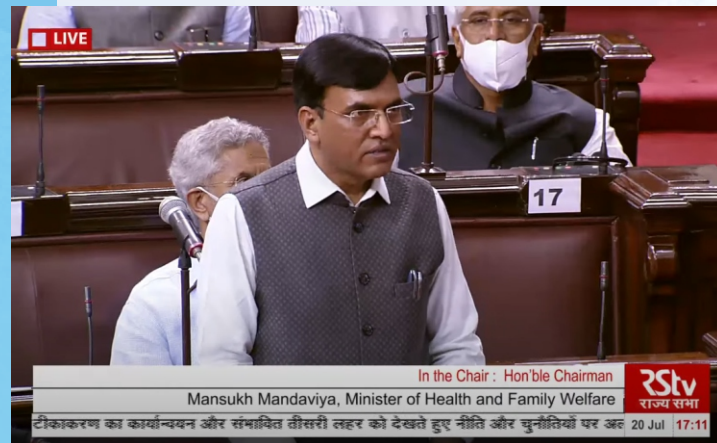

## 11th BRICS Health Ministers' Meeting



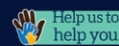

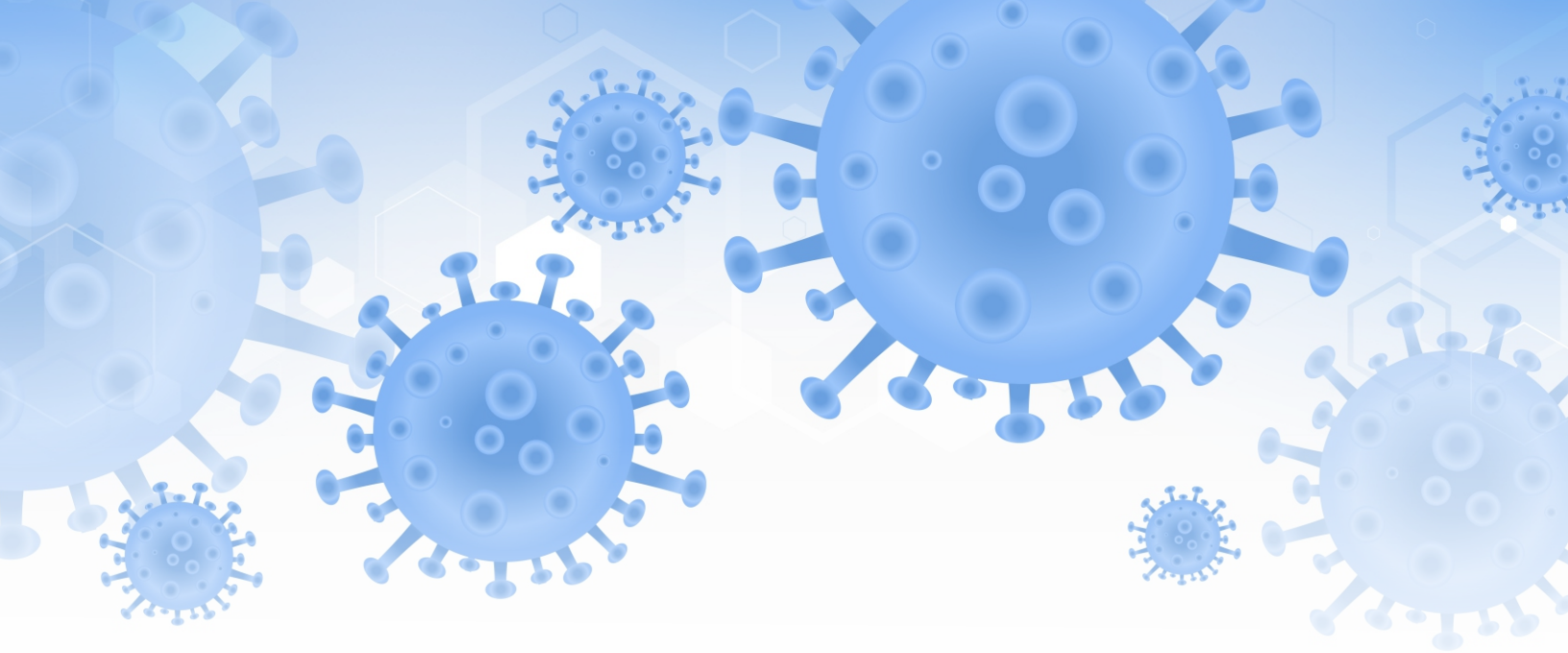
## Meeting with Honourable President of India

Shri Mansukh Mandaviya met with the Hon'ble President of India, Shri Ram Nath Kovind and sought his expert guidance on various matters of public importance.



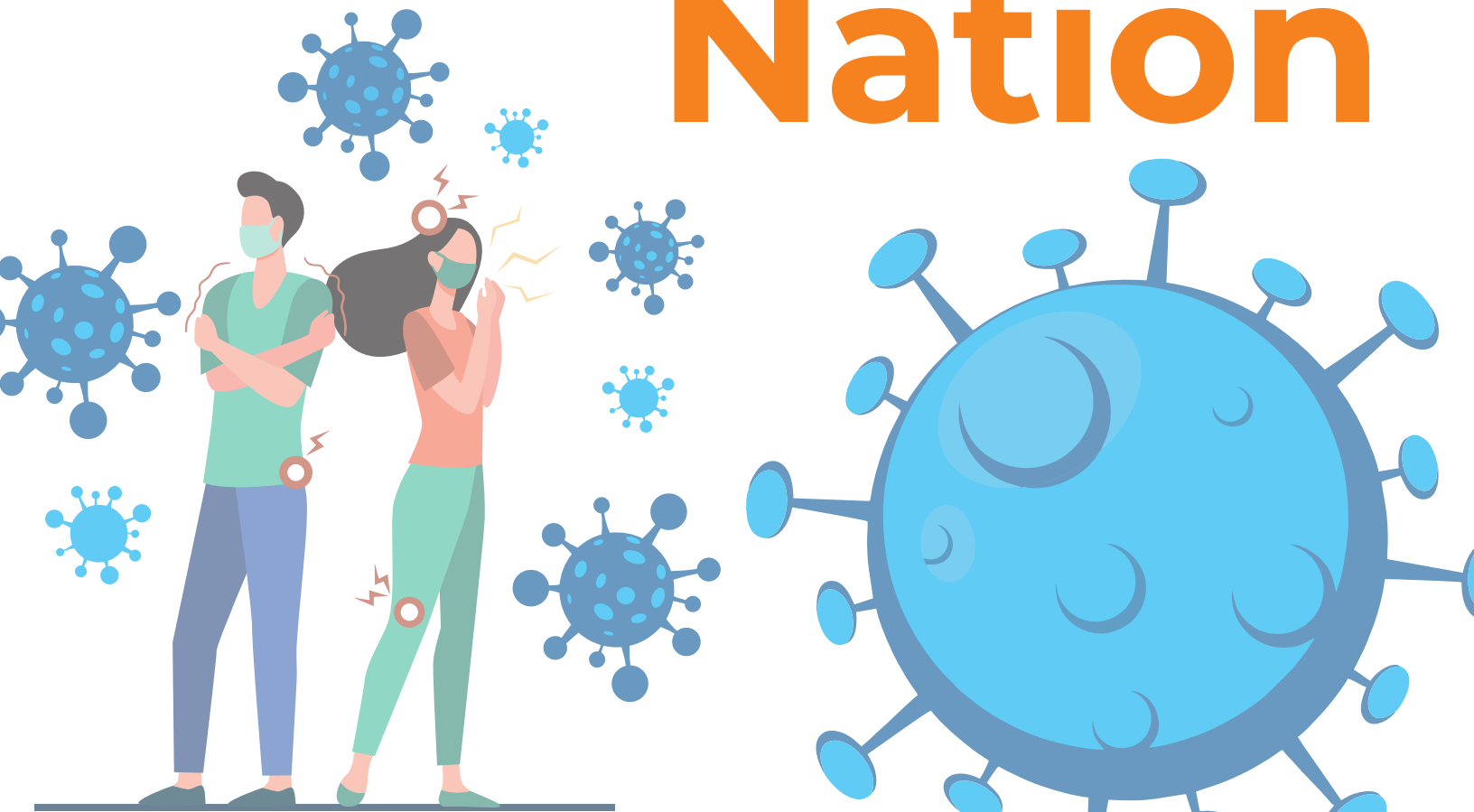

In an exemplary feat, all the eligible citizens residing in 196 villages of Tripura have received their first dose of COVID-19 vaccine.



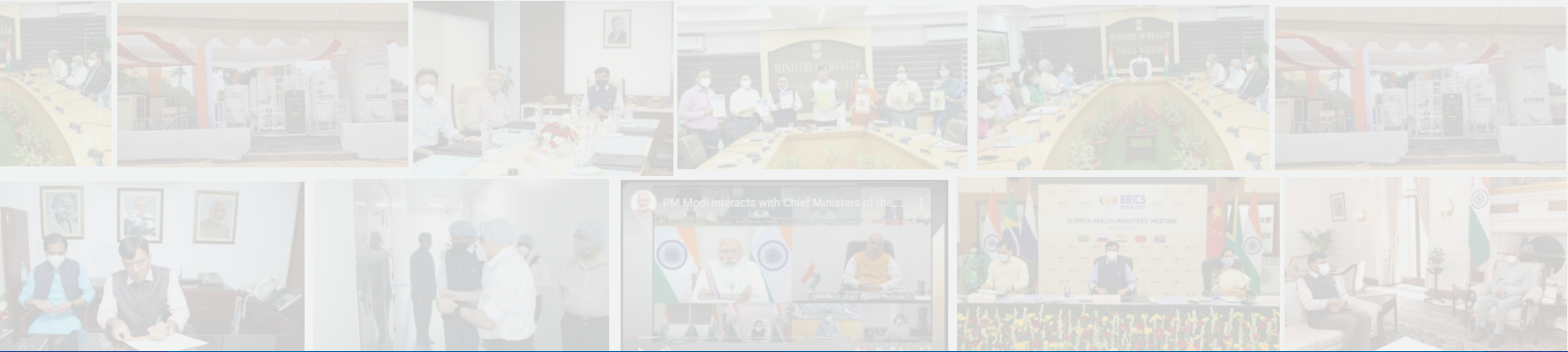
