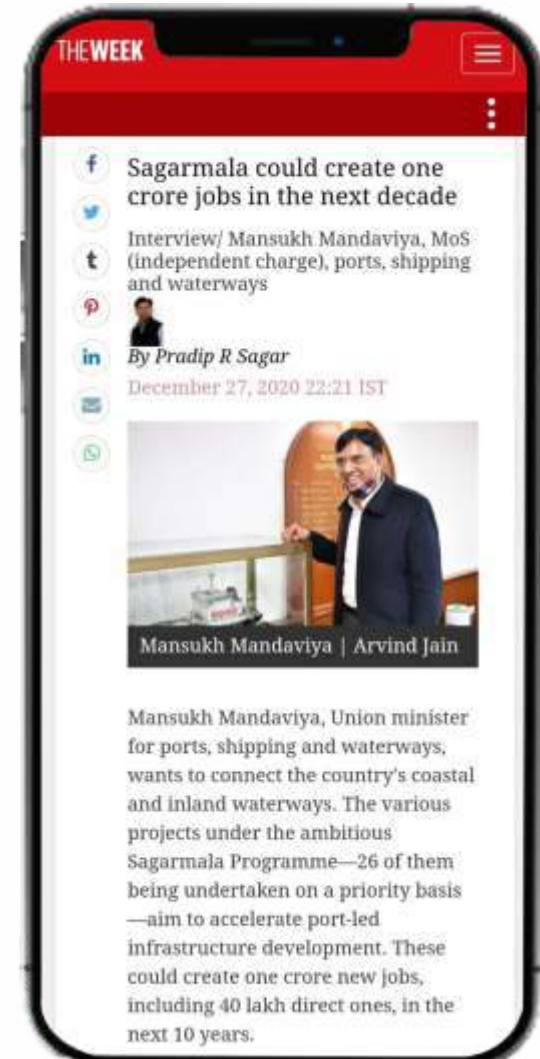

This will help in de-congestion of the ports, reduce sea freight as a result of handling large volumes, boost industrial economy, generate employment opportunities and usher a port-led development in Odisha and eastern India as per PM Narendra Modi Ji's vision of Purvodaya
