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





India Will Invest USD 82 Billion in Port Projects By 2035: PM Narendra Modi

NEW DELHE: India will invest USD 82 billion in port projects by 2015, raise share of clean renewable energy source in matitime sector, develop waterways and boost tourism around lightbouses as pair of port-led development, Prime Minister Narendra Modi soid on Tuesday.

Speaking at the Mantime India Samurit, he invited global investors to invest in Indian ports, shippards and waterways. He said that more than 534 projects cooling USD K2 billion of 88-6 lakk crore have been identified for implementation between 2015 and 2035 under the Sagarmala Project.

The government, he said, is looking to operationalise 25 waterways by 2030, "Ours is a government that is investing in moreousy in a way that was never seen before. Domestic waterways are found to be cost effective and environment friendly ways of transporting feeight," he said.

Also, plans have been drawn for developing tourism on land adjacent to 78 out of 189 lighthouses on Indian coastline. "This with the objective of enhancing development of the exoting lighthouses and its surrounding areas into unique maritime tourism landmaths," to said adding the government has also initiated itolistic development of slands.

Morgside, the usage of clean renewable energy in the matime sector is being raised. "We are in the process of installing solar and wind based power systems in all the major ports across the country. We aim to increase usage of renewable onergy to more than 50 per cent of all energy by 2030 in those phases across indian ports," he said.

phases across indian ports," he said. Moth said, indian ports have reduced waiting time for inbound and outbound cargo. "India is very serious about growing in the maritime sector and emerging as a leading Blue Economy of the world," he said.

NVEST IN OUR ports. Invest in our people. Let India be your preferred trade destination. Let Indian ports be your port of call for trade and commerce,"PM Narendra Modi said at the Maritime India Summit-2021, inviting global investors. His words define the aspirations of New India and its ports & maritime sector.

The Indian maritime sector accounts for 95% of EXIM trade by volume, and is a significant employment generator. India's coastline is 1.05% of the global coastline, and the country accounts for 10.4% of global maritime trade in FY 2019. It contributes 9.03% of the total seafarers (officers) globally, making it an integral part of the shipping ecosystem.

India's position in the global maritime sector is fundamental for international trade. This trade is facilitated by the growing port capacity in India. In FY 2019, the capacity for Indian ports stood at 2,377 million tonnes per annum (mtpa) while it handled traffic of 1,281 mtpa. Twelve major ports accounted for 1,514 mtpa of capacity and handled 699 mtpa of traffic, leading to utilisation of a mere 46.2%. Non-major ports, which account for 863 mtpa of capacity, handled 582 MTPA traffic-an utilisation of 67%. Thus, key enhancements in policy, investment, operations and technology are critical to bringing India to the forefront of global maritime trade.

The ministry of ports, shipping and waterways has launched the Maritime India Vision 2030 (MIV-2030) to continue driving accelerated growth in the sector. MIV 2030 projects cargo traffic to reach 2,570 mtpa by 2030. The vision outlines 10 broad

Charting course for maritime growth

The Maritime India Vision 2030 can help India become a maritime superpower, with worldclass ports & shipping

themes, encompassing 150+ initiatives covering all the facets of the Indian maritime sector-an effort to define and meet national maritime objectives. These initiatives are broadly aimed at development of port ecosystem, port operations and services, waterways and, shipping and cruises.

For ports, world-class infrastructure will form the backbone of the envisioned transformation. In line with global trends of mega-ports, development of four mega-port clusters with capacity of than 300 mtpa are planned in Gujarat, Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu and West Bengal-Odisha. These clusters were post evaluation of industrialisation and hinterland-connectivity potential. Since the sector has been moving towards mega vessels, an increase of the draft at all major Indian ports is targeted.

India's strategic location has long required development of a transshipment hub. Hence, for better efficiency of the coun-

try's maritime trade, the ministry would work towards developing a transshipment hub (TS) in South India. At present, approximately 75% of India's transshipment cargo is handled by ports outside India, including Colombo, Singapore and Klang. This increases the cost/TEU for EXIM players. Therefore, there are plans to increase the transshipment capacity through accelerated operationalisation of such ports, development of green-field TS ports at Kanyakumari and Campbell Bay as additional transshipment hubs in a phased manner, and increase capacity of existing ports like Cochin.

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are negatively impacting seamless trade. Hence, steps have been identified in MIV to improve ease of doing business in the maritime sector. A National Logistics Portal (Marine) is to be launched as an integrated platform for all EXIM stakeholder, senabling 100% paperless processes. It will the focal point for domestic shipment tracking, cloud-based document management, digital payments, etc. Additionally, more than 50 smart interventions, like predictive maintenance, deployment of automated quay cranes, etc, have been identified to transform major ports into smart ports.

Concrete steps have been identified for driving Aatmanirbhar Bharat through increased manufacturing and decreasing logistics cost. Pockets with high potential to undertake port-led industrialisation, spread over 6,000 acres, have been identified. This would be complemented with projects aimed at reducing logistics cost, such as development of commodity-specific infrastructure at ports for promoting coastal shipping and automation/mechanisation of operations. Together, these initiatives would push Make in India, Make for the World

MIV-2030 also aims at building safer and environmentally-sustainable ports. Increased share of renewable energy in port operations, sustainable use of dredging material, reducing freshwater consumption and emissions, promoting development of 'zero accident' ports and real-time monitoring of HSE KPIs are some of the key measures to develop Green Ports.

On the shipping front, MIV aims to make India the leading ship recycling and repair hub, while increasing the gross tonnage of ships built in India by more than 15 times. This would be achieved through channelisation of domestic demand for ship-building and repair, leveraging Right of First Refusal (RoFR) rules under Aatmanirbhar Bharat Scheme. India has already demonstrated strong ship-building capability with several shipyards delivering good quality vessels globally. Repair and recycling clusters would be developed, with usage of scrap material promoted through modification of BIS regulations and re-development of ship recycling infrastructure at Alang.

Further, to increase regional maritime cooperation and trade, a Bay of Bengal Initiative for Multi-Sectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation (BIMSTEC) centre is planned to be established in India. It would facilitate infrastructure investment and trade agreements with BIMSTEC countries. Efforts would also be made to develop and export India's core competencies like IT, naval architecture, and maritime training to support other developing countries.

India is endowed with various Inland Water Transport (IWT) options comprising rivers, canals, backwaters, creeks, and tidal inlets. These provide environmentallyfriendly mode of freight logistics and passenger transport with lower operating costs. The government has prioritised development, over the next ten years, of 23 NWs with significant traffic potential. NW 1 (Gan-ga-Bhagirathi-Hooghly system) and NW 2 (Brahmaputra) hold immense significance as they connect neighbouring countries with India's hinterland. These waterways are to be connected to form the Eastern Waterways Connectivity Transport Grid, providing for cost-effective EXIM with Bangladesh, Bhutan, Myanmar and Nepal.

Development potential of sectors like cruise tourism (both river & ocean cruise) has also been identified as a part of the vision. To this end, government has already undertaken several measures like rationalisation of port charges, cabotage relaxation for foreign vessels, expediated immigration and development of cruise terminals. Themes-based coastal and island circuits have also been identified on a priority basis.

MIV aims to increase the share of Indian seafarers in the global talentpool. Advance ments in maritime trade would lead to evolution in capabilities for on-shore operations. Accordingly, training programmes focusing on maritime skills would be launched in partnership with industry.

MIV will make India a maritime superpower, creating ~20,00,000+ more jobs and propelling India towarsds realisation of the '\$5-trillion economy'goal.

Modi says \$82 bn will be invested in ports by 2035

NEW DELHI, MAR 2

INDIA will invest USD 82 billion in port projacts by 2035, raise share of clean renewable energy source in maritime sector, develop waterways, augment scaplane services and boost tourism around lightbouses, PM Modi said on Tuesday urging global players to make India a "preferred investment destination".

As many as 400 projects with investment potential to the tune of USD 31 billion are ready for investors, who can be a part of India's growth trajectory. Modi said inaugurating the Maritime India Summit.

"More than 574 projects at a cost of USD 82 billion or Rs 6 lakh crore have been identified under the Sagarmala project for implementation during 2030 and 2035... We will encourage private investment in the port sector... India's long coastline awaits you. India's hardworking people await you.

"Invest in our ports. Invest in our people. Let India be your preferred trade destination. Let Indian ports be your port of call for trade and commerce," the Prime Minister said as he invited players to invest in Indian ports, shipyards and waterways.

The Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways is ready with a list of 400 investable projects with investment potential of USD 31 billion or Rs 2.25 lakh crore, Modi said adding, this will further strengthen India's commitment of overall development of its maritime sector.

"Through this Maritime India summit, I want to invite the world to come to India and be a part of our



growth trajectory. India is emerging as a leading blue economy of the world. Our leading focus area includes upgrading current infrastructure, creating next generation infra, boosting the reform journey. Through these steps we aim to give vision to our Aatmanirbhar Bharat," he said.

Modi further noted that "ours is a government that is investing in waterways in a way that was never seen before. Domestic waterways are found to be cost effective and environment friendly ways of transporting freight. We aim to operate 23 waterways by 2030."

He said this will be done through infrastructure enhancement, fairway development, navigation aid and river information system provisions and focus will also be given on augmenting regional connectivity to Bangladesh, Bhutan and Myanmar.

New Maritime Infra will usher in ease of living through launch of roll-on, roll-off and other projects for hamessing rivers.

"Waterdromes at 16 locations are being developed to enable scaplane operations... River cruise terminal infra and jetty are being developed on five national waterways. We aim to develop domestic and international cruise terminals by 2023," the Prime Minister said.

Asserting that the govemment is working towards holistic maritime development that is not in silos, he said plans have been drawn for developing tourism on land adjacent to 78 out of 189 lighthouses on Indian coastline.

"This with the objective of enhancing development of the existing lighthouses and its surrounding areas into unique maritime tourism landmarks," he said adding the government has also initiated holistic development of islands.

Alongside, the usage of clean renewable energy in the maritime sector is being raised.

"We are in the process of installing solar and wind based power systems in all the major ports across the country. We aim to increase usage of renewable energy to more than 60 per cent of all energy by 2030 in three phases across Indian ports," he said.
