Operational Readiness For Cyclone Yaas!




In the wake of Cyclone Yaas, Shri Mansukh Mandaviya took stock of the preparedness of all Major Ports on the eastern coast of India.

DAP fertilizer subsidy from Rs. 500 per bag to Rs. 1200 per bag.








